

MINUTES
March 9, 2026

The City Council of Badger met in regular session at 6:30 p.m. at Badger City Hall with Mayor Roger Curtis presiding. Council members present: Teresa Larson-White, Jeff Brundige, Nathan Jones, and Michael Hendren. Absent: Larry Hall. Also present: Jennifer Schild, Tyler Marsh, Arissa Echevarria and Sarah Jones. Motion to approve the agenda was made by Hendren, second by Jones, all ayes, motion carried. Motion to approve the consent agenda was made by Larson-White, second by Brundige, all ayes, motion carried. The consent agenda consisted of minutes from the February 9th meeting minutes, clerk/treasurer report for February and bills in the amount of \$19,684.94. There was no unscheduled business. Under communications and reports, Library director, Tammy Haack submitted and discussed her written report to Council regarding library happenings. Mark Wertz presented his written Public Works Department report which included numerous maintenance tasks, work with equipment, utility locates, etc. Glenda Rasmussen, City Clerk, presented her written report to Council. Council member Hendren discussed saying the Pledge of Allegiance at council meetings and having a “meet your city representatives” get together. Mayor Curtis reported on recent meetings attended and upcoming Lions Club events. Under regular agenda items, Tyler Marsh proposed cleaning city park equipment and concrete at both Knudson and Jones parks. He quoted a cost of \$440.00. Motion to approve was made by Hendren, second by Larson-White, all ayes, motion carried. Council, mayor and clerk discussed final FY27 budget numbers. Council discussed a quote for a 3 year contract with Viking Industrial Painting for inspection and cleaning of the water tower totaling \$7,000 over 3 years. Motion to approve made by Jones, second by Brundige, all ayes, motion carried. Final item was discussion of a quote for a street-sweeper attachment for the recently purchased skid loader in the amount of \$6,786.80. Motion to approve made by Hendren, second by Jones, all ayes, motion carried. There being no other business, motion to adjourn was made by Brundige, second by Jones, all ayes, motion carried. Adjournment at 7:10 p.m.
